







The Linnéa Yacht Group are proud and extremely excited to announce the World Premiere of the new Najad 380 Aphrodite, making her public appearance for the first time at the 2009 PSP Southampton Boat Show.

Created for yachtsmen and women with a passion for beauty, tradition and craftsmanship, the Najad 380 Aphrodite represents the first in a line of three yacht models that celebrate the beauty of sail.

The concept behind the range has been to take the hull form from three previously successful and well proven centre-cockpit Najad yachts - the 380, 460 and 511 and outfit them in a more traditionalist way, guaranteed to appeal to anyone looking for something more personalised and more out of the ordinary than a 'normal' cruising yacht.

Under the skin, the Aphrodite Line will benefit from modern manufacturing techniques, for example, hulls will be built from vacuum-infused vinylester at The Linnea Yacht Group's 7,000sq.m facility in Åmål, Sweden, which opened in 2007.

Standard cruising rigs will be offered, designed for a couple to sail with ease, although the quality of the fixtures and fittings on deck will be of an extremely high quality.

In evidence on the new Najad 380 Aphrodite, and something that sets the range apart, is distinctive styling of the coach-roof superstructure, which is trimmed, liberally, with encapsulated varnished mahogany veneer all around and regarded a 'signature' feature of the new yacht. Other 'classic' features, such as teak laid decks and polished stainless-steel 'dorade' style vents and port-lights, reinforce an overall solid and traditional look and feel.

Creating the right atmosphere and ambiance inside the new Aphrodite Line has been considered very important. 














Najad 380 - 380 Aphrodite Line
